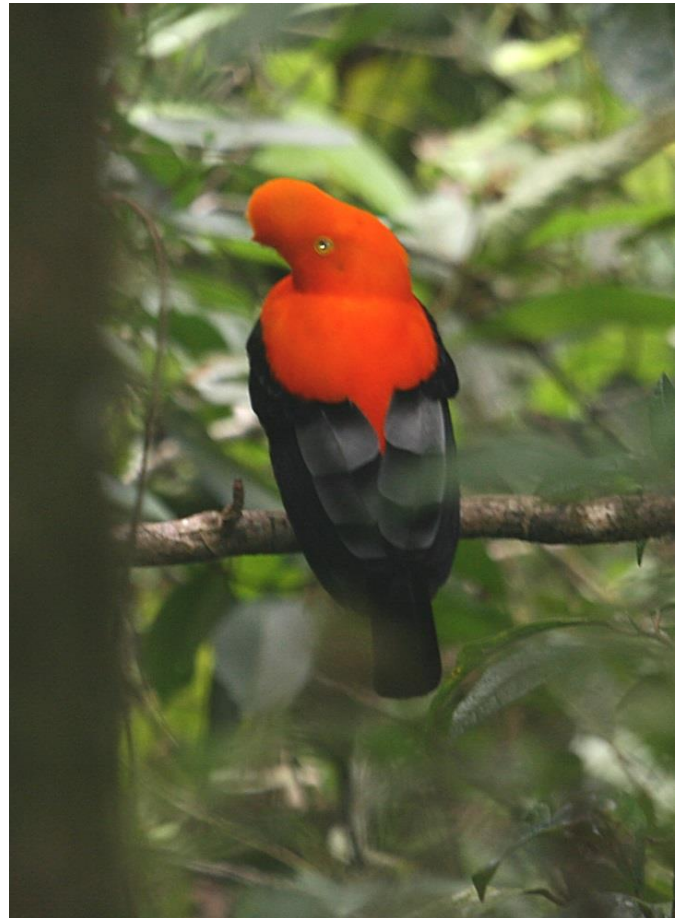

NEW ZEALAND

Birders Rest was established in 2005 since when our trips to see North Island Brown Kiwi have become well-known worldwide, with over 800 people having enjoyed the experience. We also continue to run day tours to see the other special birds of New Zealand's Far North, and day pelagics to find the fantastic variety of seabirds off the nearby coasts.

NORTH PERU

Birders Rest extended its operations to this part of South America following an opportunity for voluntary exploration work in 2008 through Lluís Dalmau. We set up a programme of tours in 2012 under the name Birding North Peru and have taken groups of birders there every year since 2012. Our 8th tour leaves in August 2016. Exploration of new areas within North Peru continue and will add variety to the tours in the next few years.

INDONESIA

A chance meeting with the operators of Ecolodges Indonesia led to a purchase of shares in this innovative company. This led the way to a new destination for some very exciting birding. After exploration in 2015, tours began in March 2016 to Bali, Flores, Java & Kalimantan. This is to be repeated in 2017 and 2018 in a combination of tours including Sumatra. Other islands are in the planning stage, such as Sulawesi and West Papua.

A specialised 4 day trip to look for the unique and recently discovered Scarlet-banded Barbet in the remote forested hills south of Tarapoto. Many other species (Yungas Manakin, Subtropical Pygmy Owl, etc.)

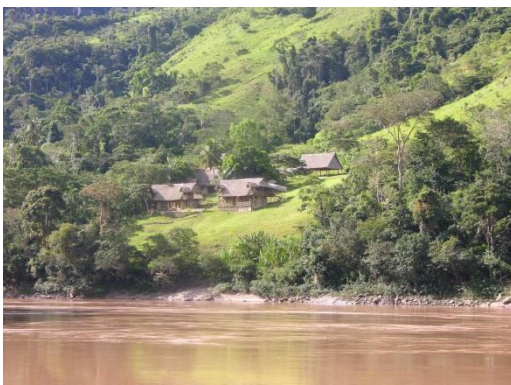

THREE WEEK TOUR 2017 – TARAPOTO TO CAJAMARCA

- Begins at Pumarinri Lodge on the Huallaga River, riverside birds from the boat, at least 6 species of owls around the lodge at night.
- Dry whitesand forest at Quebrada Upaquiuhua and Juan Guerra, habitat for speciality birds.
- Higher altitude forest at Cerro Escalera, the 'Tunnel', Aconabikh hummingbird reserve, lowlands.
- Route to Moyobamba past the Oilbird ravine, hummingbirds & forest trail at Waqanki.
- Reserva Arena Blanca for tinamou feeding station and more hummingbirds
- Abra Patricia & surrounding cloud forest at 2300m. Rich in birds including Long-whiskered Owlet. Laguna Pomacochas.
- Rio Chido trail from San Lorenzo for up to 3 species of antpittas.
- Huembo Reserve for hummingbirds including Marvellous Spatuletail
- Gocta Falls – trails to the spectacular Falls, cloud forest & Andean scenery, Cock-of-the-Rock leks, speciality birds.
- Kuelap archaeological site
- South to Leymebamba, over elfin forest of Abra Barro Negro at 3800m and down to the Maranon River at Balsas.
- Celendin, Cruz Conga & La Encanada
- Rio Chonta / Chugur, San Marcos & Andean lakes near Cajamarca
- Sangal, Cumbemayo & Abra Gavilan near Cajamarca



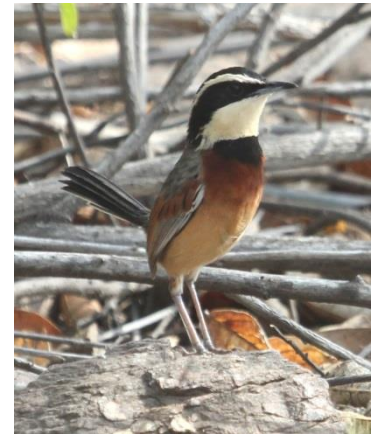

EXTENSION – CHAPARRI ECOLOGE & PACIFIC COAST

- A 4 day extension to Chaparri Lodge in the dry scrub of the western Andes with a variety of birds not usually seen on the main tour.
- Full day on trails around the Lodge.
- Day in the higher altitude forest at Casupe.
- Morning at Laguna Tinajones.
- Coastal marshes and lagoons around Santa Rosa and Puerto Eten.
- Morro de Eten for coastal bird colonies & sea-watching.

TWO WEEK TOUR – CHICLAYO to TARAPOTO

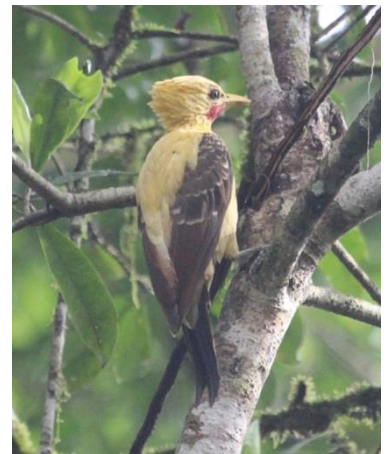
In 2016 we are travelling back to where we started at Tarapoto via a different route to explore new sites, leaving on 9th Sept from Chaparri or Chiclayo and returning to Tarapoto on 21st Sept. We then fly out to San Lorenzo by one of the Amazon tributaries (not the antpitta site by the same name) looking for a new set of lowland forest species including the little-known White-masked Antbird.

You are welcome to join us & there is still room at Chaparri & at San Lorenzo if you wish to add these on. We are going anyway. Bargain price.

In 2017 & 2018 this will be a flexible tour and include old & new sites such as:

- Tucume & the Pyramids, Bosque de Pomac, Abra Porculla.
- Cerro Chinguela cloud forest & route to Tamborapa & Jaen.
- Gocta, Huembo & Huaylla Belen cloud forest.
- Granada Highlands & Abra Patricia.
- Rio Romero river trip – (our 2 trips here have been fabulous).
- Huallaga River at Pumarinri.
- **EXTENSION** to San Lorenzo del Maranon in the lowlands (by air).

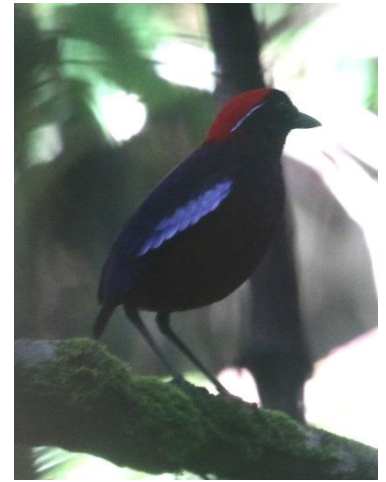

- A repeat (with modifications) of our successful tour in March 2016.
- Arrival in Denpasar, stay at Udayana Lodge; Nusa Dua Settling Ponds
- On to Flores, stay at Bajo, day trip to Komodo Island
- Birding Labuan Bajo area & overland to Ruteng for Flores endemic birds
- 3 days in Tanjung Puting National Park, Kalimantan, stay at Rimba; riverboat trips, wild Orang Utans, Garnet Pitta & Bornean Bristlehead.
- Java – Pulau Rambut Island, Maura Angke marshes, Gunung Gede Pangrango National Park.
